Work Zone Awareness Week

April 17-21 was National Work Zone Awareness Week, and the 183 North Mobility Project wants to call attention to the importance of work zone safety. In 2020, 857 people were killed due to a work zone incident according to the National Work Zone Safety Information Clearinghouse.

Plan ahead when driving along the corridor or any construction zones so that you can be prepared. When driving through a work zone, be sure to slow down and pay attention to your surroundings. We can all do our part to practice safe driving and help ensure the people working in construction zones make it home to their families.
