




Purpose of the Project






Project Highlights

Additional two express lanes in each direction



Additional collector distributor to the southbound MoPac frontage road



High-tech traffic monitoring system for improved traffic management and safety, emergency response








Existing vs. Future Conditions


MoPac/US 183 Interchange

- **5** Exit north of Far West Blvd.

Benefits to the Community



- Increased **mobility** in corridor
- Improved response times for emergency vehicles



- **Safe connectivity for pedestrians** throughout the corridor through continuous, ADA compliant sidewalks
- Connected bicycle lanes at specific intersections throughout the corridor
- **Better visibility** through upgrades to 568 lights with LED, high mast lighting increases safety
- Utilizing Next Generation Concrete Surface for an improved roadway surface










Construction Phasing for MoPac

Phase 1 of Next Generation Concrete Surfacing neared completion










Installation of new High Mast Lighting for driver safety

Concrete batch plant erected close to project that will support daily concrete paving operations









Constructed strategic project access points from U-Turn lanes at Great Hills Trail, Oak Knoll, and RM 620

Center median excavation and drainage installation










Began drill shafts, and bridge columns and caps for bridge widenings and direct connector structure



Project Look Ahead for 2023



Work to begin on direct connector and collector-distributor road improvements at MoPac

Advancing belowground and aboveground components of bridge work (columns and caps, bridge decks), bridge widenings and direct connector structure





Project Look Ahead for 2023



New drainage and wall construction to begin between frontage roads and mainlanes

Subgrade work and concrete paving in center median pavement

Installation of ITS communications throughout corridor




