 Design-Build






Project Highlights



The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority is bringing mobility improvements to US HWY 183 by building the 183 North Mobility Project which will include:



Adds two express lanes in each direction



Adds a collector distributor to the southbound MoPac frontage road



High-tech traffic monitoring system for improved traffic management and emergency response




Creates direct connect from MoPac via new express lanes

Project Benefits



- Increased mobility in corridor
- Safe connectivity for pedestrians throughout the corridor through continuous, ADA compliant sidewalks



- Connected bicycle lanes at specific intersections throughout the corridor
- Better visibility through upgrades to 568 lights with LED, high mast lighting
- Reduced traffic noise through next generation, concrete surfacing
- Improved response times for emergency vehicles



Phasing for Main Lanes – 183 North










Phasing for Main Lanes - Loop 1
