

WHAT WE'VE ACCOMPLISHED

The 183 North Mobility Project is set to reshape the transportation landscape along the US 183 corridor which spans approximately 9 miles from SH 45 North to MoPac in northwest Austin. Our purpose is clear – to enhance safety, optimize connectivity, and improve local mobility for the region.

Looking back through 2023, the 183 North construction crews made great strides in work near MoPac, widening existing bridges for improved mobility at the US 183 and MoPac interchange. Furthermore, driveway reconstructions along US 183 picked up steam as crews have been restructuring business entrances on frontage roads as a part of revitalizing and adding new sidewalks to the corridor that meet ADA standards. In late 2023 crews started to focus on retaining walls to widen US 183, where we'll eventually be adding a much-needed fourth non-tolled general-purpose lane. Want to learn more? 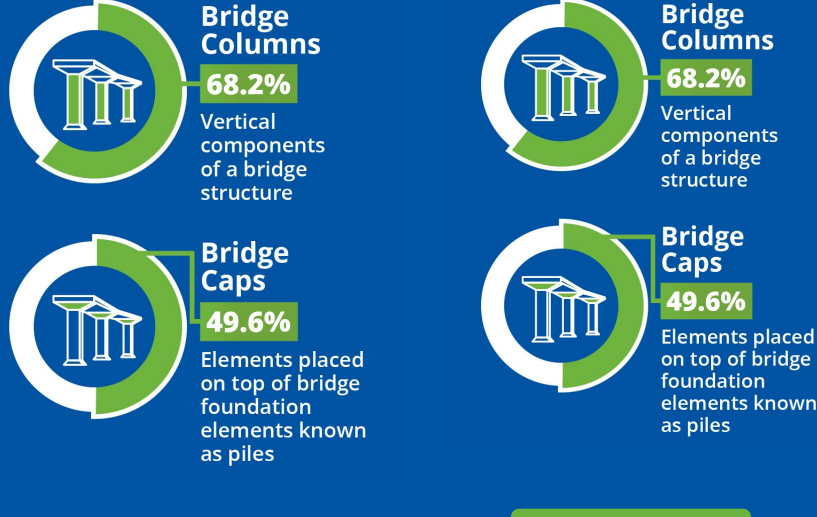
A look at construction progress and community outreach

A Look Ahead

This newsletter may be all about what we did in 2023 and what's ahead in 2024, but if you want a crystal ball look at what the 183 North Mobility Project will bring upon completion slated for 2026, take a look below:



Express Lanes:

Imagine zipping through your commute with not one, but two, tolled express lanes in each direction. Fasten your seatbelts for more reliable travel times!



Improved Non-Tolled Lanes:

We're giving US 183 an upgrade with four non-tolled or "general-purpose" lanes in each direction. That means in areas where only three lanes currently exist, we're adding an extra lane for good measure!



Direct Connector:

Think express lane direct connector linked with the MoPac Express Lane, creating seamless connectivity for your travel adventures.



Visual Enhancements:

We're not just building roads; we're sprucing up the corridor with aesthetic enhancements and landscaping.



Bike Lanes and Sidewalks:

Get ready for multiple sections of fresh Shared Use Path and improved cross street connections linking key bike lanes along the corridor and 11 miles of new and/or improved sidewalks, making your journey by foot more accessible and ADA-compliant.



Operational Improvements:

Ever heard of a collector-distributor road? Ours will run along MoPac from the direct connector to the southbound MoPac frontage road until Far West Blvd., allowing travelers to bypass intersections and get to their destinations more easily. Talk about smooth sailing!



Increased Safety:

Most importantly we're improving safety, not just through roadway mobility improvements, but also by significantly increasing visibility to commuters during nighttime or low-visibility events, such as bad weather, through new LED high-mast lighting fixtures along the corridor, as well as improving drainage features.
