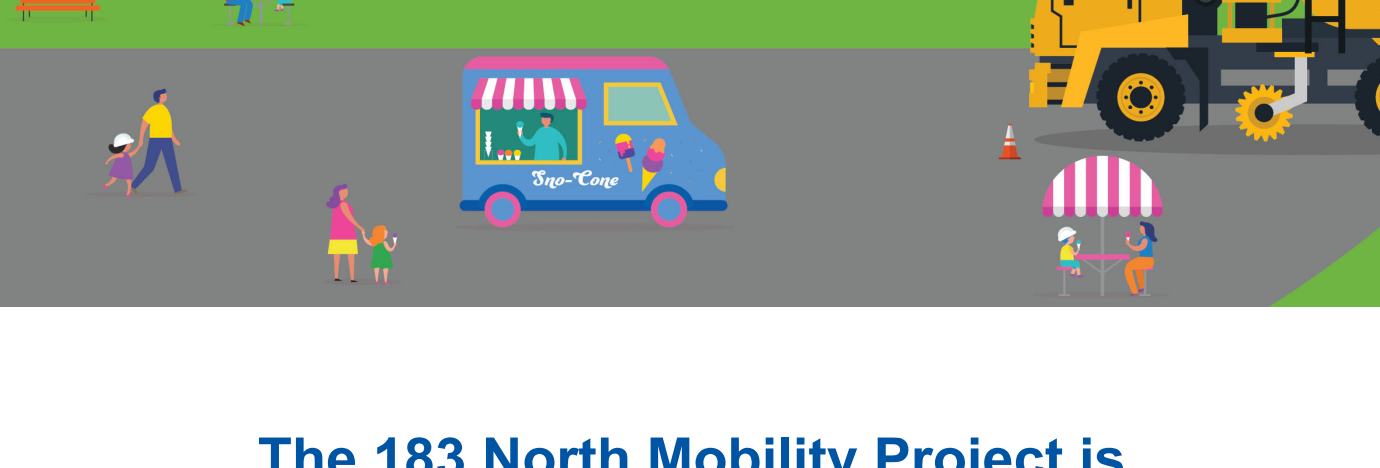

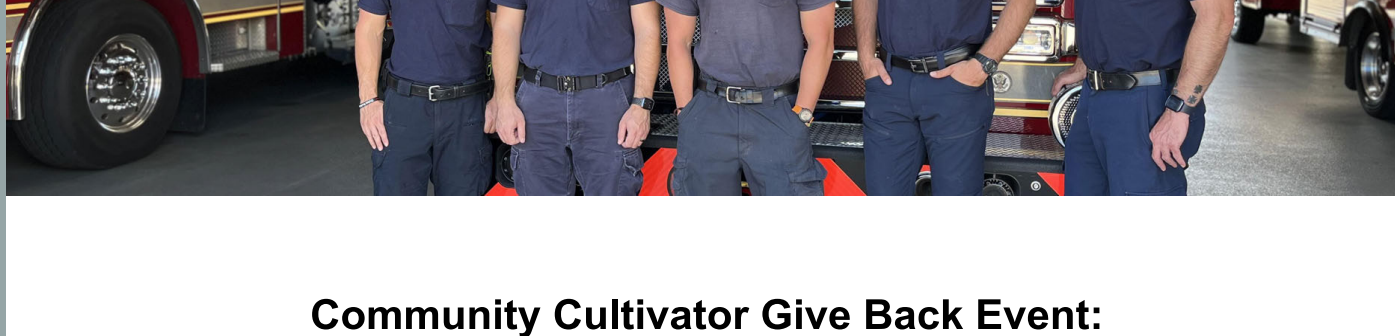
The 183 North Mobility Project is Coming in Hot This Summer!

The project team is continuing to actively meet with neighborhood associations. Visit our website to request a meeting for your neighborhood.

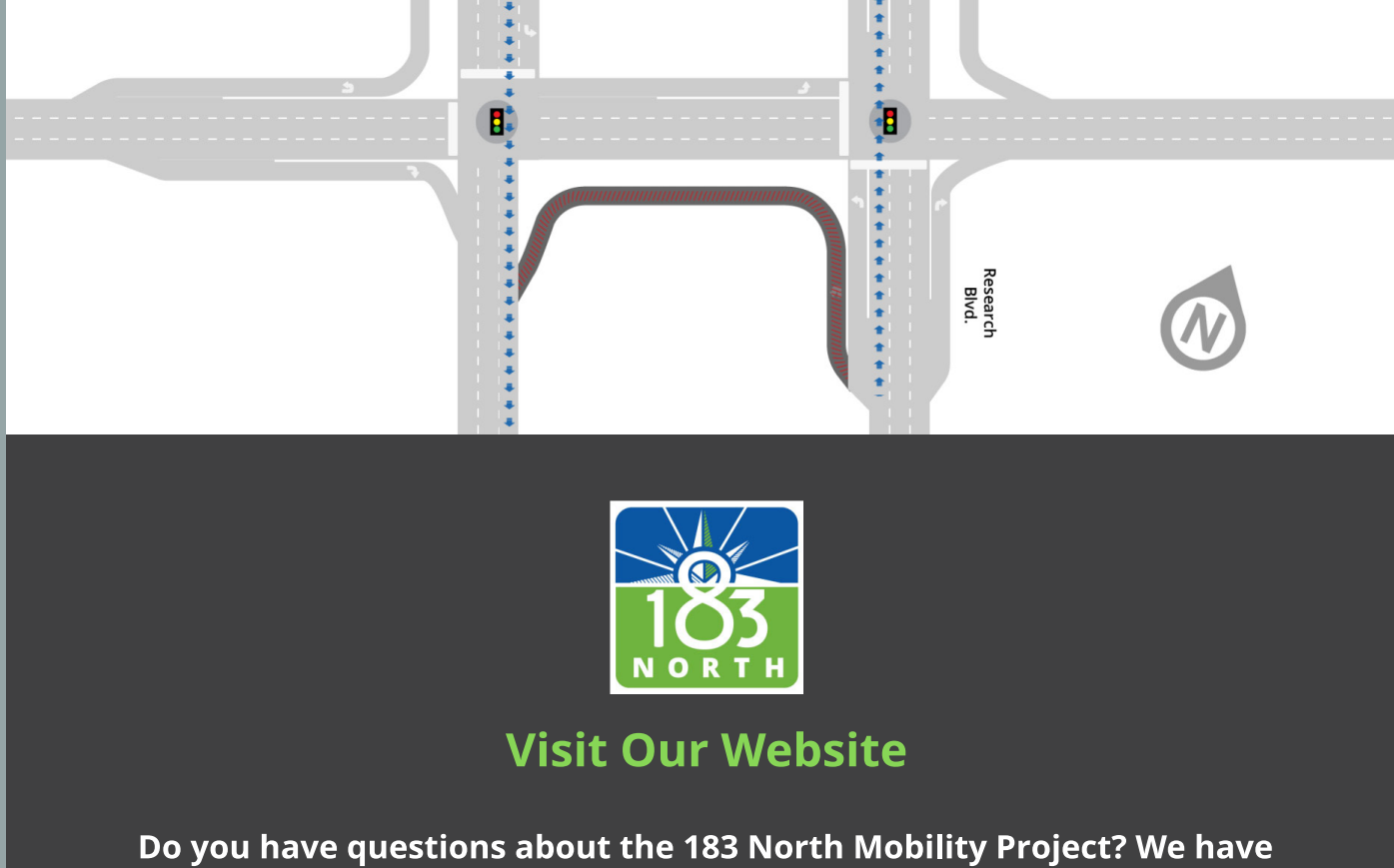

What You'll See on the Road

Great Hills Constructors (GHC), who is constructing the 183 North Mobility Project for the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority, will close the US 183 U-turn at RM 620 for northbound to southbound traffic. This closure allows us to build access ramps to the median for construction vehicles, thereby reducing the potential for future traffic delays. 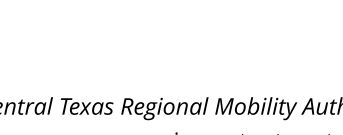
