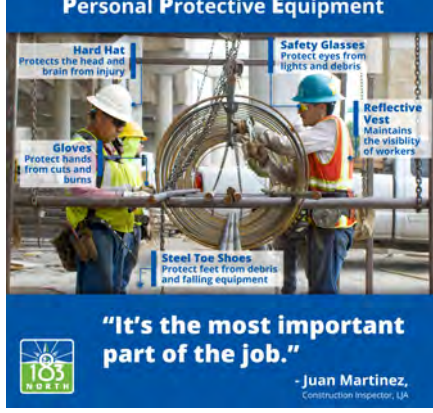
Help Our Crews Get Home Safe
