The 183 North Mobility Project corridor now has one additional travel lane in both directions, bringing the total to four lanes in each direction where there were only three before. This accomplishment means smoother, more reliable travel as construction continues, and it's something that we've prioritized bringing to fruition as quickly as possible as a part of the many mobility improvements coming to northwest Austin through this project.

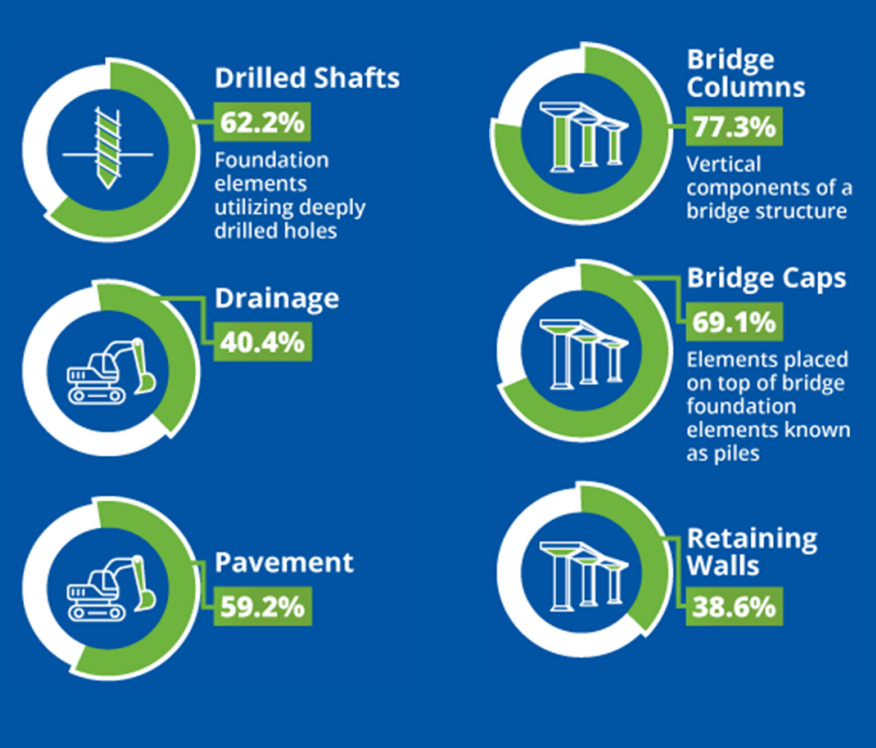

team members to bring improvements to northwest Austin. More positions will be added in 2024!

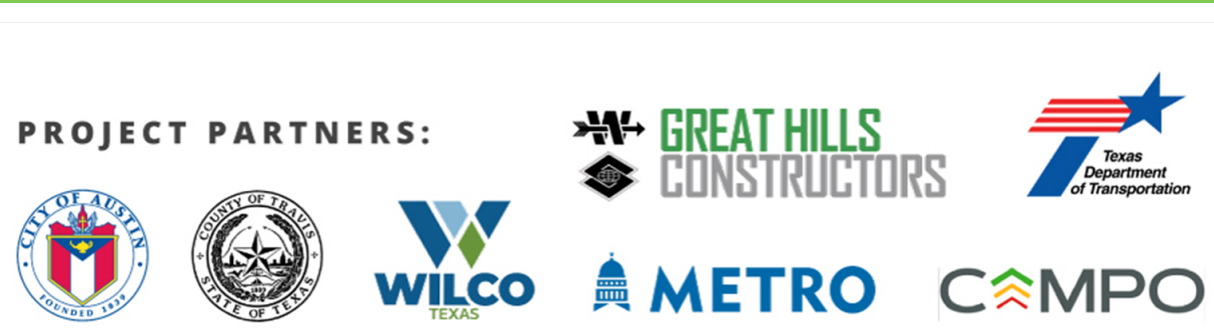
